

Recognise the signs of Terrorism-Related Suspicious Activity

SCaN

See, Check and Notify

1. SEE

Recognise what's normal and what isn't. Be vigilant for suspicious activity.

SCaN

2. CHECK

Use conversation to find out if activity is suspicious or not

3. NOTIFY

Know how and when to report suspicious activity. Including when it is reported to you by someone else.

Recognise the signs of Terrorism-Related Suspicious Activity

Action Counters Terrorism



Expressed or Implied Threat:

Threatening to commit a crime that could harm or kill people or damage property



Surveillance: A prolonged interest in or taking pictures/ videos of personnel, facilities, security features or infrastructure in an unusual or covert manner



Theft/ Loss/ Diversion: Stealing or diverting items such as equipment, uniforms, badges or identity tags that belong to a facility or secured site



Testing or probing of security: Investigating or testing a facility's security or IT systems

Aviation Activity: Operating or interfering with the operation of an aircraft that poses a threat of harm to people and property

Breach/ Attempted Intrusion: Unauthorised people trying to enter a restricted area or impersonating authorised people

Acquisition of Expertise: Gaining skills or knowledge on a specific topic, such as facility security, or flying an aircraft

Eliciting Information: Questioning personnel beyond mere curiosity about an event, facility, or operations



Materials Acquisition/ Storage:

Acquisition and/or storage of unusual materials such as cell phones, radio controllers, or toxic materials



Cyberattack: Disrupting or compromising an organisation's information technology system



Recruiting/ Financing: Funding suspicious or criminal activity or recruiting people to participate in criminal or terrorist activity



Sabotage/ Tampering/ Vandalism: Damaging or destroying part of a facility or infrastructure or placing signs or stickers on infrastructure



Weapons Collection or Storage:

Collection of weapons including explosives, chemicals, or other destructive materials



SEE, CHECK and NOTIFY

Misrepresentation: Presenting false information or misusing documents to conceal possible illegal activity
